You must be willing to accept their faults and work to help them overcome them. Parrots, even through they are domestically raised, are still wild animals and can be unpredictable at times.

We realize that there are circumstances that change and that sometimes, you may not be able to keep the bird you adopt. If this is the case, YOU MAY NOT give the bird away or sell the bird. YOU MUST return the bird Parrot Island Bird Toys “Bird Haven” for re-adoption. Your adoption fee is non-refundable. We reserve the right to refuse adoption to anyone we feel is not a good fit for the bird. There will be no refunds on birds due to illness or death once they have been adopted. All birds are adopted as is with any health or behavior issues being fully disclosed prior to adoption.
